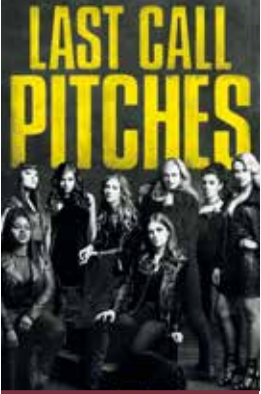


PITCH PERFECT 3

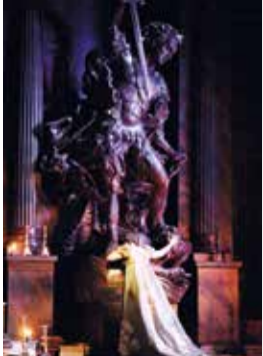
ROYAL OPERA HOUSE LIVE: RIGOLETTO
